## TASTING NOTES

Another new addition from the 2009 vintage is our new white Rhone blend, "88." Think of this as a lighter/alternative version to our flagship white, XCV. Although made in the same style as XCV, utilizing 500L French oak puncheons for both fermentation and barrel maturation, this blend is more suited for the summer with its brighter flavors and crisper acidity. This is due to the significantly higher percentage of Grenache Blanc which we use in the XCV to round its usual girth from the Viognier and Roussanne. In this blend, however, these varietals provide mouth feel and structure. With flavors of honeysuckle, jasmine, grapefruit, white peach, and the ever present minerality from the soil in which the fruit is grown, this wine a perfect accompaniment to spring and summer gatherings.
