TASTING NOTES

The Syrah planting, at 14 acres, is one of the largest blocks on the property and covers a variety of aspects and soil depths. As a result, the grapes were harvested over seven picks spanning roughly two weeks. The 07 “Jersey Girl” is a selection of barrels from each of these picks designed to offer up subtle nuances and add to the overall intrigue of the wine. The grapes were hand harvested, de-stemmed and gravity fed to 1.5 ton and 3 ton open top fermentors. Each lot then underwent an extensive pre-fermentation cold soak. Over the next three weeks the lots were fermented separately utilizing only punch down for cap management. Upon dryness the lots were gently basket pressed and aged in barrel for 18 months prior to blending. The wines were then bottled unfined and unfiltered in May 2009.
